





## Go Global 2017 - Leading for the Future!

A global learning conference for teachers and pupils, exploring and enabling pupil leadership for a fair and sustainable world.

<u>Cumbria Development Education Centre</u>, in partnership with The Lakes School, is hosting its third *Go Global* conference - and this year it's even more ambitious, supported by workshops in schools and training for teachers during Spring term.







The theme will be *Leading for the Future*, and will be an opportunity for Year 5 children to explore and develop their own leadership skills, to learn more about global challenges such as climate change, sustainable energy, migration and global inequalities...and run their own campaign or project that will really make a difference.

Based on the "I, We, Planet" model of young global leadership, year 5 pupils will:

- ✓ learn more about the Global Sustainable Development Goals and how everyone can take a part in them locally
- ✓ gain skills and confidence in presenting their ideas to an audience
- ✓ understand that they can make a difference locally and globally understand the role of a leader and teams in solving problems



"The 'I' concerns our connections within self and the exploration of personal values. The 'We' is about our connections with others, both locally and in the wider world, and it is about our shared interdependence. The 'Planet' concerns our connections with the physical earth and our interdependence with it and the non-human beings that share its space."

Young Global Leaders from Year 8 at the Lakes School will help to design and run the event, and your pupils will have the chance to learn more about what global leadership means from them.
